Temporary Policy Changes – COVID 2019

The Trustee of the Burns & Roe Asbestos Personal Injury Trust recognizes that these are difficult and unusual times. Some filers may be unable to meet the requirements for the handling and disposition of certain Trust Claims. Accordingly, until a subsequent notice is issued by the Trustee, the following temporary policies will be in place:

- A release document or an affidavit that currently requires notarization or two unrelated witnesses may be signed by the Injured Party or Personal Representative (when the injured party is deceased) and one witness who *may be* related by blood or marriage.
- The timeframe for responding to notices of offer, deficiency, deactivation and withdrawal is tolled.
- The statue of limitations period for filing a claim is tolled.

Permanent Policy Changes

The Trust makes the following permanent policy change, effective immediately: The Trust will accept any document requiring a signature that has been signed utilizing DocuSign or other electronic signature software.
